The APA Publication Manual uses a very complex system of headings. This template follows APA naming conventions for heading styles and is preset for a paper using four levels of organization. If you require a different number of levels of organization, you will need to select styles based on the number of levels you are using. Please see Section 3.32 of the APA Publication Manual for details on APA heading conventions.

Please note that some cleanup will be required before finalizing the paper to send to the publisher if you have used EndNote to insert figures in your paper. Because of limitations in Word, it is not possible to set figure captions to automatically have the title of the figure italicized but not the number and the word "Figure." You will need to override the italics for the "Figure X" portion of the figure captions. Also, you will need to remove the captions from the figures themselves in the final version to be sent to the publisher after removing field codes. Finally, if your article has more than one author, and the authors are not from the same institution, you may need to clean up the authors list on the title page to meet APA requirements that multiple authors from different institutions be separately listed.
